A climate change and environment expert with a PhD in Environmental Science from the University of Aberdeen, UK, I have been actively involved in addressing environmental and climate change issues in Bangladesh through collaboration with the government, UN agencies, and multilateral development banks. I have held key positions, including Director (Climate Change and International Convention) at the Department of Environment (DoE) and Director (Planning, Development, and Negotiation) at the Bangladesh Climate Change Trust (BCCT).

As a practitioner of GRM, I am working as complaint handling and grievance redress officer of PKSF, address the complaint of individual and community level. Right now I am handing as a GRM officer of three GCF projects, one adaptation fund project and one project of GiZ. I have degree on environmental science as well as practical knowledge and experience on GRM issues.

I have played a significant role in formulating crucial national climate policies and frameworks, including the National Adaptation Programme of Action (NAPA) 2009, the National Adaptation Plan (NAP) 2022 (with the finance section authored by me), and the Nationally Determined Contributions (NDC) of Bangladesh for 2015 and 2021. My contributions extend to the Climate Fiscal Frameworks of 2014 and 2020, the Country Investment Plan for Environment, Forest, and Climate Change (CIP-EFCC) 2017, and the NDC Implementation Roadmap 2018.
